TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Rules of Participation

Show and Tell is aimed at UK based participants aged 11-18 years old.

1. If you are between the age of 11-15 consent for participation is required from a parent/legal guardian.
2. By submitting a photo to Show and Tell, you are validating it as your original work and that you own all of the rights to it.
3. If your photo includes identifiable people in the picture, you confirm you have their permission to publish the image (permission required from the parent/legal guardian if your picture includes a child under the age of 16).

Image Usage

When you share, post or upload any content to the Show and Tell programme, you hereby grant to The Photography Movement a royalty-free, worldwide license to use, host, distribute, modify, publish or display your content to promote the Show & Tell campaign for young mental health and any other future Show and Tell campaigns for young mental health.

By submitting your photo(s) to our exhibition via the Show and Tell 'How Do You Feel?' photography 'Mission,' you accept the terms of service of our partner EyeEm and you grant EyeEm permission to use, host, distribute, modify, publish or display your content to promote the Mission on the EyeEm website, app, and marketing channels including social media.

Rules for Communicating

1. In all forms of communication and written messages always use a friendly, polite language. Insulting, offending, slandering, defaming, discriminating, or making personal attacks against someone for any reason is strictly prohibited. Never use rude language.
2. When commenting on another participant's photos you are required to be extra careful and kind.
3. You acknowledge and agree that Show and Tell has the right to delete any written message or other text or material submitted by you at any time and for any reason.

Prohibited Conduct - YOU AGREE NOT TO:

1. Use the Service for any illegal purpose or in violation of any laws or regulations
2. Violate or encourage others to violate third party rights, including the infringement or misappropriation of intellectual property rights;
3. Upload, post, or publish any User Content that is unlawful, defamatory, libellous, objectionable, profane, indecent, pornographic, harassing, threatening, hateful, or otherwise inappropriate;
4. Perform fraudulent activities, such as impersonating another person or lying about your date of birth

We reserve the rights to report any worrying images we receive that represent self-harm or violence to a relevant third party or support group.
